



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All sophomores and juniors who have an accumulated **GPA of 3.780 or better after the fall semester may apply for membership into the National Honor Society.**

HOW TO APPLY:

Applicants must... a) complete the student information sheet, b) obtain two activity recommendations, and c) obtain three character recommendations. These forms must all be turned in by the indicated deadline.

ONCE ACCEPTED FOR MEMBERSHIP

- 1) He/she must pay the \$10.00 induction fee, the cost of the NHS pin (\$8.00), and the GCHS activity fee (\$10.00), for a total of \$28.00.
- 2) He/she must participate in the induction.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Grades: 3.780 to apply for membership
- 3.730 to maintain membership** **If grades fall below 3.730, members have one semester only of probation. In case of dismissal, the card and pin must be returned.
- Service: 1) NHS Group Projects 2) 12 service hours performed yearly *2 in-school hours per semester (examples: tutoring without pay, volunteering at an athletic events) *2 community hours per semester (examples: volunteering at church or assisting elderly in your neighborhood) *2 your choice (either category) Members may not receive pay for service.
